



### 1. SHORT VIDEOS

### (For college students):

### Guidelines:

- Students are required to form groups of a maximum of three belonging to any college to participate in the short video making competition (groups containing members from different colleges are allowed).
- Groups are supposed to find out interesting phenomena or thought experiments from their surroundings that showcase exciting facets of sciences and make a short video of 5-6 minutes while demonstrating and explaining the science behind that phenomenon.
- The topic of the video should be unique and **not be plagiarized** from other external sources.
- 4. There will be **no entry fees**.
- 5. All participants must register themselves before submitting their entries.
- 6. The minimum resolution required for the short video is 1080p or 1920 X 1080 pixels.
- 7. The short video should be submitted in .mp4 format.
- 8. The file must be named in the following format:
  - <First Name>\_<Mobile Number>.mp4
  - For example, if your name is Pema Namgyal and your registered mobile number is 0123456789, then you must name your file as **Pema\_0123456789.mp4**
- 9. The short video should start with a black screen with the name of the participants on it along with their credentials for a duration of 5 seconds.
- 10. Each group registered must send only one entry (no multiple entries per group).
- 11. Video entries will be accepted through the registration google form itself. **The** deadline for the short video making competition is 24th April (Sunday), 2022. Any submission after the deadline will not be considered a valid submission.
- 12. The video submissions will undergo a two-step evaluation where any submission not satisfying the above-mentioned points will be disqualified in the first step, the rest of the entries will be sent to the judges for further evaluation.
- 13. Three winners will be selected via this evaluation process, and cash prizes will be awarded to the winners.

### **Guidelines:**

- 1. The event is being conducted in two categories:
  - Category A: Students in 8th, 9th and 10th
  - Category B: Students in 11th, 12th and 1st Year of undergraduate degree
- 2. There are no registration fees.
- 3. All participants must register before sending their entries.
- 4. The entries must be typed and be submitted as **pdf** documents. Handwritten entries will not be accepted.
- 5. The file must be named in the following format:

### <First Name>\_<Mobile Number>.pdf

For example, if your name is Pema Namgyal and your registered mobile number is 0123456789, then you must name your file as **Pema\_0123456789.pdf** 


- 6. A participant must mention their Name, School, Category (A or B) and Registration Number at the beginning of the document.
- 7. A participant is allowed to send just one entry.
- 8. The entries must be based on the prompts shared.
- 9. The prompt used must be clearly stated in the document.
- 10. The entries should be uploaded on the provided Google Form by 24th April (Sunday), 2022. Any submission past the deadline will not be accepted.
- 11. Three winners will be selected, and cash prizes will be awarded to the winners.

1st prize - Rs 3000

- 12. An entry must not exceed 1500 words.
- 13. Entries will be accepted in the English language only.

### 3. SCIART

### (For school students and 1st Year undergraduates):

### **Guidelines:**

1. There are two categories:

Category A (For Students in Class 9th - 10th)

Category B: Students in 11th, 12th and 1st Year of undergraduate degree

- 2. No entry fee is required.
- 3. All participants must register themselves first before submitting their entries.
- 4. Drawings can be done either on art or regular paper, depending on the participant's preference. Colours can be used in any way you like. **Digital works are not allowed**.
- 5. Any form of drawing (pencil, watercolour, comic strip etc.) is allowed. Give a title to your art (the word limit is 15 words).
- 6. A high-resolution snapshot of the drawing to be emailed in .jpeg or .png format, with a file size not exceeding 10MB. In the drawing, please include your name, class, school, and topic name at the top right corner of the sheet.
- 7. The renaming and sizing of your photographs are crucial. Rename your image files to include your first name as well as your registered mobile number. For example, if your name is Pema Namgyal and your mobile number is 0123456789, then you must name your file as Pema\_0123456789.jpg
- 8. A participant can send only one entry per category. No group participation will be entertained.
- 9. The theme of the competition must be followed in all entries.
- 10. **Drawings will be accepted with the deadline of 24th April 2022**. After which drawings will not be considered.
- 11. Three winners will be selected from each category, and cash prizes will be awarded to the winners.
