As you are aware, the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) is an apex organisation under Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. It assumes the responsibility of advising and assisting the Central and State Governments on policies and programmes for qualitative improvement in school education. The NCERT functions through its eight institutions located in different parts of the country viz., National Institute of Education (NIE), consisting of 18 Departments/ Divisions/Cells at New Delhi; five Regional Institutes of Education (RIEs) located at Ajmer, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Mysore and Shillong; two central institutions namely, Pandit Sunderlal Sharma Central Institute of Vocational Education (PSSCIVE) at Bhopal and Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET) at New Delhi.

The NCERT disburses its responsibilities by way of conducting research, development, training and extension activities/programmes. The constituents of NCERT every year propose academic programmes based on the mandate of National Policy of Education (NPE) as well as the needs of the States. These programme proposals undergo rigorous scrutiny of various boards/committees before final approval. One of the most important amongst them is the Institutional Advisory Board (IAB)/ Departmental Advisory Board (DAB) for which the Director, NCERT nominates eminent academicians and renowned scholars as member. The major role and responsibilities of IAB (for the Institutes)/DAB (for the NIE constituents) are as follows:

- to consider the programme proposals submitted by Institute/ Department/ Division/ Cell in the light of its role and functions.
- to recommend the programme proposals considered suitable by the IAB/DAB to Academic Committee (AC)/Management Committee (MC)


