## CIRCULAR

Subject: Guidelines on availing COVID-19 Vaccination.

Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India has started 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of COVID Vaccination to cover beneficiaries above 60 years of age and those aged from 45 to 60 years and having comorbidities as mentioned in Annexure-I(A) of Circular issued by MoHFW (Guidance doc COWIN 2.0 MOHFW website.docx, dated 28.02.2021) [copy enclosed].

- 2. In view of the commencement of COVID-19 Vaccination nationwide, Competent Authority in HWB has decided to issue following guidelines regarding COVID vaccination to the CHSS beneficiaries at HWP Baroda, Manuguru, Talcher and Tuticorin.
  - A) All CHSS beneficiaries aged 45 to 60 years and having comorbidities can obtain Medical certificate in the prescribed format (copy enclosed) from the Medical Officer of the concerned Plant.
  - B) They may avail vaccination facilities at centres of their choice and convenience (both Government and Private Hospitals). The cost of vaccination incurred at Private centres (Rs.250/-) will be reimbursed.
  - C) CHSS beneficiaries fulfilling the criteria and who are desirous of taking vaccination may self-register on COWIN website at <a href="https://www.cowin.gov.in">www.cowin.gov.in</a> OR via Arogyasetu app.
