Usage Policy

- Electronic Resources such as e-journals, e-databases, and e-books are made available by the NISER Library for academic use.
- These resources can be searched or browsed and material may be downloaded & printed as a single copy of articles, as is done in the case of printed library material. Downloading or printing a complete book, an entire issue, or a journal volume (called systematic downloading) is strictly prohibited.
- Using robots, spiders or intelligent agents to access, search or systematically download from these resources is also prohibited. Any violation of this policy will result in penal action as per the rules and regulations of the Institute.
- Please be aware that systematic downloading will cause the publisher to block to the entire community of users @NISER from accessing these resources.

The terms and conditions for using these resources are spelt out in electronic resource license agreements with each publisher. Individual users must ensure that the use of electronic resources does not breach the terms and conditions specified in the license agreements. Licenses vary from publisher to publisher; however, the general principles are as follows:

Permitted

- Viewing, downloading, copying, printing and saving a copy of search results
- Viewing, downloading, copying, printing and saving individual articles
- Using e-resources for scholarly, educational or scientific research, teaching, private study and clinical purposes
- Sending a copy of an article to another authorized user (i.e. current faculty, students or staff)
- Posting the URL to the publisher's version of the article on a class website (publisher's link will allow only authorized user access)

Not Permitted

- Use of robots or intelligent agents to do systematic, bulk or automatic downloading is not permitted.
- Systematic downloading or printing of entire journal issues or volumes or large portions of other e-resources is not permitted.
- Using e-resources for commercial gain is not permitted (i. e reselling, redistributing or republishing licensed content).
- Transmitting, disseminating or otherwise making online content available to unauthorized users (i.e. sending or mailing lists or electronic bulletin boards) is not permitted.
- Posting the publisher's version of PDF of an article to an open class website is not permitted (instead, post the URL to the article which will allow only authorized users access).

Breaches of the license agreement with publishers could result in the suspension of access to the resources for the entire NISER community
