ABOUT

The Central Library is a unique information centre, offering access to essential and specialised information resources and other services to meet the growing information needs. The library's mission is to enhance and enable discovery by effectively utilising these resources. All the students, faculty members, and institute employees of NISER can use library facilities. The library building, with a carpet area of 60,000 sq. meters, occupies a central location on the campus. The combined seating capacity of the first and second floors of the library is nearly 400 at a time. It has a rich collection of books on Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Earth & Planetary Sciences, Humanities, Computer Sciences and Medical & Radiological Physics.

The Library remains open 365 days a year.



OVERNIGHT BOOK ISSUE

Library members can issue Reference books for reading overnight. The reference section issues books after 8.00 p.m., and the borrowed materials are to be returned to the section before 10.00 a.m. the next day. Repetitive delay in returning the books would result in the denial of the overnight issue facility for that member. The members can borrow only one book at a time for the night. The fine for delay in returning a book is Rs. 5 per day.

- Use of robots, spiders, or intelligent agents to access, search or systematically download from these resources is prohibited.
- These resources can be searched and browsed, material may be downloaded and printed as single copies of articles as is done in the case of printed library material. Downloading or printing a complete book, an entire issue, or a volume of one or more journals (called systematic downloading) is strictly prohibited.
- Any violation of this policy will result in penal action according to the rules and regulations of the Institute.
- Please be aware that systematic downloading will cause the publisher to block the entire community of users at NISER from accessing these resources.

- Newspapers, magazines, and journals must be read only in the library on designated tables and should not be taken to other reading areas.
- No library material can be taken out of the library without permission. The unauthorized removal of anything belonging to the library will be treated as theft and dealt with accordingly.
- Anyone who violates the rules and regulations of the library would be liable to lose the privilege of library membership and may be debarred from using the library facilities.




