Details of Recruitment Tests

Stage-1-Preliminary Test

Date : 21st November 2020 (Saturday)

Time: 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Stage-2-Advanced Test

Date : 22nd November 2020 (Sunday)

Time: 10:00 AM – 12:00 Noon

Venue: Lecture Hall, Library Building

Stage-3-Skill Test

Date:- 23rd November 2020 (Monday)

Time:- 10:00 AM onward

Venue:- Health Centre, NISER Campus

Examination Pattern:

Stage 1 – Preliminary Test: Screening examinations to be held to shortlist candidates. The format of the screening examinations will be as follows:

1. Examination will consist of 50 multi choice questions (choice of 4 answers) of one hour duration in the following proportion:

a. Mathematics - 20 questions

b. Science - 20 questions

c. General Awareness – 10 questions

2. '3' marks for each correct answer and '1' mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer.

3. All candidates scoring less than (<) 30% in OBC category and less than (<) 40% in other categories will be screened out.

Stage 2 – Advanced Test: All candidates Screened in Stage-1 will be allowed to undertake Stage-2 (Advance Test) **in their respective trade.**

1. The Test will comprise 50 multi choice questions (choice of 4 answers) of two-hour duration.

2. '3' marks for each correct answer and '1' mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer.

3. Merit List of candidates will be prepared after Stage-2, based upon the scores obtained in Stage-2 only.

4. All candidates scoring less than (<) 30% in OBC category and less than (<) 40% in other categories will be screened out.

Stage 3 – Skill Test: Based upon the Merit List prepared after Stage-2, candidates will be shortlisted for Stage-3 (Skill Test). Candidates clearing the skill test will be shortlisted and empanelled in order of Merit based on the marks secured in Stage-2.

1. The number of candidates shortlisted for Skill Test will depend upon the number of candidates qualifying for Stage-2 but will not exceed 4-5 times the number of vacancies in each trade.

2. The Skill Test will be based on "Go/No-Go" basis.

IMPORTANT NOTE

With reference to the advertisement No. **NISER/Estt./Rct./01/2019** :-

- The questions for Written Examination will be of multiple choice types. The total number of questions will be 50 and duration will be 01 hour (60 minutes) for preliminary test whereas, 02 hours (120 minutes) for advanced test. The syllabus will be as described above in the 'examination pattern'.
- There will be negative marking in the written test.
- Admission to written examination is purely provisional and shall be subjected to fulfilling the eligibility criteria and conditions laid down in the advertisement. Candidates are advised to check their eligibility for the applied post. The candidate will be disqualified at any stage of examination even after also, if he/she does not satisfy the essential eligibility conditions.
- Entry to the examination hall will not be allowed without this admission card. The Candidate should also bring a valid photo ID proof in original and a ball point pen.
- Enter the examination hall 60 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- Candidates shall not be admitted to the examination hall if they report after 10 minutes of commencement of examination.
- Electronic devices/Cellular phone/Mobile/Pager/Calculator etc shall not be allowed in the Examination hall.
- Mere issuing of admit card, appearing in the written test, and/or skill test does not confer any right on the candidate to be selected.
- Original documents will be verified before Stage-3 Skill Test. So all the candidates are requested to come with all certificates, mark sheets, caste certificate, experience certificate and any other relevant documents in original along with a set of photocopy with them for verification positively.
- No TA/DA will be provided to attend the stage-1 & stage-2 written test for the said post. However, TA in second sleeper class / bus fare from the place of residence to NISER and back shall be reimbursed by the institute as per rule those who will attend the stage-3 skill test only.
- Written examination and skill test will be held at the venue as mentioned above. Request for change of venue will not be entertained.
- The candidates should strictly comply with the directions given to them by the test administrator/invigilator. If any candidate found disregarding these directions, he/she will be liable to be debarred from the test.
- The decision of the competent authority through the entire process of recruitment is final and binding in all respect. No further correspondence whatsoever shall be entertained in this regard.
- Candidates are requested to follow the COVID guidelines strictly. Wearing of mask/face cover is mandatory.
- Candidates are requested to come at least 2 hours before the test so that thermal screening at the main gate and admit card etc. can be checked in time. Only candidates will be allowed to enter into the campus. Parents/guardians will not be allowed.
